SELECTION ELIGIBILITY – THE APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a Brunswick High Graduate.
- Attending a four-year college.
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Must have completed some type of community service hours / tasks.
- Participated in at least 1 other extracurricular activity.
- Include a copy of High School Transcript.
- Include two letters of recommendation, one from a former or current teacher, principal, guidance counselor and one from an individual outside of school.

**H2O Foundation Scholarship – a total of \$1,000 may be awarded annually to graduating seniors.

Application must be submitted to the High School Guidance Office no later than Friday April 6, 2018. If selected to receive one of the scholarships, it will be awarded when verification of full time enrollment is received. Please do so before July 15.
